35TH ANNUAL MACC SPRING FLING COURTHOUSE SHOW FILLS EARLY

The 35th annual "Spring Fling" Festival will take place in Mason May 3 through May 6 this year, with the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce's signature Courthouse Show being held on Saturday, May 5 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Special events will be taking place all around the Mason area during the Thursday through Sunday festival presented by **Dart Container Corporation**. Go to the www.masonchamber.org website and click on "Events" for the latest information.



Some events are weather dependent and a few of the activities have an admission charge. Mason's Spring Fling Festival starts on Thursday, with a National Day of Prayer breakfast and evening service on the **Ingham County Courthouse** lawn, events at the **Mason Library**, bingo at the **Masonic Hall**, and line dancing at the **VFW 7309 Hall**.

The 30th annual **Commercial Bank Mason 5K Run/Walk** will be on Friday, May 4. The race starts at 7:00 p.m. on Maple Street, just north of the downtown's **Ingham County Courthouse**. This is a popular mid-Michigan race that attracts people from many surrounding localities. The net proceeds benefit the **Mason Public Schools Foundation**.


The signature event of Mason's Spring Fling begins Saturday morning May 5, with the 35th annual Courthouse Show downtown. The show is held outdoors -- rain or shine on Saturday only from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Elaine Ferris of the **City of Mason**, chair of the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce's Spring Fling and Down Home Days committee says that "this year's show filled up weeks before and our estimates are that between 4,000 and 6,000 people attend this show each year." She also notes that "the show features a mix of arts and crafts, food vendors, community groups and other booths." This year the show filled with crafters, community booths, and other vendors earlier than ever.

During the Courthouse Show, there is entertainment at 1:00 p.m. on Maple Street with the Shahira Dancers sponsored by **Commercial Bank Mason**. A "Kids' Korral" children's activity area sponsored and hosted by the **Mason Rotary Club** will be located near the west Courthouse steps. Admission is charged for the kiddie rides, some games, and bounce house. This is also the tenth anniversary of the "kid's Korral" vendor **Mason RailTime Adventures**.

Many more things happen on Saturday at other locations in Mason. The **Mason Firefighters Association** will have a pancake breakfast from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the **James M. Pelton Memorial Fire Station**, 221 W. Ash Street. There will again be a pie and bake sale at **Mason Area Historical Society's Museum**, 200 E. Oak Street in Mason, starting at 10:00 a.m. The **Museum** will also be open that day. **MAHS** will also have the **Pink School Museum** open from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. on Ash Street, just west of Cedar Street.

The **Rotary Club of Mason** will have their annual duck race on Sycamore Creek next to **Lee Austin Park** on Ash Street, just west of the **Mason City Hall** and across the street from the fire station, at 12:30 p.m. Select Mason area businesses will also have their sidewalk sales on Saturday, including a big event at **Michigan Barn Wood & Salvage**.

The festival concludes on Sunday, May 6. Mason's Spring Fling organizers extend an invitation to attend Sunday services at one of the many churches in the Mason area. Chamber member churches are **Mason First Presbyterian Church**, **Eden United Brethren Church**, **St. James Catholic Church**, **Life Stream Mid-Michigan**, **Mason Community Church**, **Mason First Church of the Nazarene**, **Fellowship Bible Church**, **Mason First United Methodist Church**, the **Mason Assembly of God**, and **All Saints Lutheran**. 

The drawing will be conducted by a random drawing method. Shortly after 7:00 PM on August 9, 2018, on the west side of the Ingham County Courthouse, 341 S. Jefferson in downtown Mason.
