14TH SEASON OF MASON'S THURSDAY NIGHT LIVE COURTHOUSE CONCERTS CONTINUES

Bring your lawn chairs and picnic blankets to downtown Mason on Thursday evening June 7th to enjoy the sounds of our own **Mason Orchestral Society** on the **Ingham County Courthouse** lawn. The **Mason Symphony and Chamber Orchestra**, along with the **Mason Philharmonic**, have an exciting evening of great music planned. Their musicians will play beginning at 6:00 p.m. in a free concert, hosted by the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce and sponsored by **CP Federal Credit Union**.



This is the second scheduled concert in the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce's fourteenth season of "Thursday Night Live! Courthouse Concerts." Mason's summer series of live musical entertainment is presented by **Independent Bank** on eight select Thursday evenings this year. The free outdoor concerts take place at 6:00 p.m. on the Ingham County Courthouse lawn in downtown Mason on June 7 and 21, July 5 and 19, August 9 and 23, and September 13, weather permitting. MACC has also set aside a rain date of August 30.




The **Mason Optimist Club** will be selling hot dogs, chips and pop nearby, so families can enjoy a picnic dinner during the concerts. Many concert-goers stop by restaurants and stores in Mason before and afterwards. "The Chamber hosting Thursday Night Live! Courthouse Concerts again is a way to bring more fun and excitement to downtown Mason," said Beth Yeider of **Independent Bank**, chair of the committee organizing the concerts.

She is especially happy this year since most of the performers are returning for encore performances. "We thank our sponsors and volunteers and want to let folks know that we can bring these concerts to our visitors and residents only through their generosity and the assistance of the **City of Mason** and **Ingham County**," she added.

On June 21, two weeks after this concert, local band Life Support will perform, sponsored by **Dart Container Corporation**. The entertainment series concludes with the **Mason High School Band** on Thursday, September 13, led by Beth Bousfield, **MHS Band** director. The **Mason High School Cheer Squad** will join them in the program sponsored by **CP Federal Credit Union**. All concerts are weather permitting.

MACC SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

Mike Waltz, our MACC Vice President, recently presented the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce's 2018 Agnes "Aggie" Corner Scholarships for Community Volunteerism to Will Sheffield and Zachary Troxell. The 2018 **Mason High School** graduates have been actively involved in our community while maintaining high GPAs at **MHS**. For example, Will Sheffield has volunteered at **Capital Area District Libraries - Mason Library** assisting in craft events and their summer reading program. He is interested in pursuing a degree in recreation management at Central Michigan University. Zachary Troxell has been very active in the Boy Scouts and is an Eagle Scout. He is interested in a degree in engineering at Kettering or Michigan State University, perhaps via **Lansing Community College**. The net proceeds of the annual MACC Golf Classic go toward funding the Chamber's long-time \$500 scholarship program, which now assists two students a year. The program was named the MACC Agnes "Aggie" Corner Scholarships in 2008 to honor the memory of Aggie Corner, a prominent, long-time community and Chamber volunteer.

 The **Mason Optimist Club** will again hold its Youth Sports Event for kids ages 4 to 16 at **Burchfield Ingham County Park** with free fishing on Saturday, June 9th from 9 AM to 4 PM. Registration begins at 8 AM. The only cost is the park admission at \$5 per car. Free lunch will be served to all participants and a free T-shirt will go to the first 300 kids who come. Activities include free fishing, archery, kayak and canoe paddling, water safety and more. Many of our Mason Area Chamber of Commerce members are sponsoring the event.

Dart Investment Center is the financial services firm located inside **Dart Bank** in Mason. HELP US WITH "SMART GROWTH" AND DO THE ECONOMIC CENSUS

Every five years, the U.S. Census Bureau conducts the Economic Census, the official measure of the rapidly changing landscape of American businesses and national economy. And now, it's time for business owners to respond.

Businesses are required to contribute to the economic census, according to Title 13, Section 224 of the census code. Respondents find it convenient to use the online, secure portal at the website www.census.gov/economiccensus. Information collected that could identify individuals or businesses is confidential. Data collection began May 1 with formal letters sent to multi-location and small companies. Deadline for businesses to file their responses to the U.S. Census Bureau is Tuesday, June 12.

The data is used by policymakers, governments, chambers of commerce and communities to support economic development strategy; it also provides key information in formulating a rationale for business decisions in the private sector. Further, the Economic Census is a statistical benchmark that reflects current economic activity as it relates to the indices of gross domestic product and producer prices.

Statistics offer an overview of a range of industries, including construction, wholesale, manufacturing, utilities, finance, mining, retail and services along with key insight into entrepreneurial activities and general characteristics of business ownership. The updated Economic Census, which will reflect 2017 year-end figures from approximately four million business locations, is expected to be released in September 2019.

MASON SCHOOLS AMONG TOP IN MICHIGAN

The new Michigan School Index System, which was recently released, allows parents and school staff to analyze a school’s strengths and weaknesses in a range of areas as well as lets the community get a sense of the school’s progress. Index values range from a 0-100, with a score of 100 indicating a school has met or exceeded targets in every area and for each student group.

The new Michigan School Index System speaks to the increasing quality of Mason Public Schools. Based on overall index values, Mason’s elementary schools are among the top 9% of highest rated schools in Michigan. Based on elementary schools within Ingham County, Steele ranks #4, Alaiedon ranks #8 and North Aurelius ranks #9.

“With 42 public elementary schools in the county, it’s apparent that Mason’s approach to high-quality student learning make it a district to emulate, said Ron Drzewicki, MPS superintendent. The overall index values for each of Mason’s elementary schools are: Alaiedon Elementary School 96.94, North Aurelius Elementary School 96.77, and Steele Elementary School 98.49.

All items submitted are included, subject to minor editing for publication consistency. Of course, those who are Chamber leaders and volunteers get much more frequent information e-mailed to them.

The MACC Raffle** ticket price for 2018 is \$5 per ticket to allow most people in our community to participate in supporting the MACC "Hometown USA" Fund that provides for Mason area community events, improvements, and promotions. Only 4000 tickets are available for sale. The winning ticket holders need not be present to win the prize packages. The prize package winners will be selected by random drawing from valid tickets sold.

The drawing will be conducted by a random drawing method. Shortly after 7:00 PM on August 9, 2018, on the west side of the Ingham County Courthouse, 341 S. Jefferson in downtown Mason. Officials will place and verify numbered ticket stubs in a drum. These stubs will represent all tickets sold. They will randomize the stubs in the drum and draw a ticket stub as the winner of the first prize package.

The person who owns the raffle ticket corresponding to the first drawn stub will be the winner of the First Prize Package. The Second Prize Package and Third Prize Packages will then be drawn in a similar fashion from remaining tickets. The prizes will go to the "Ticket Holder of Record" according to the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce (MACC). A "Ticket Holder of Record" is defined as the individual person recorded who purchased the ticket from a MACC individual representative.

The winners of the prize packages will take delivery no earlier than 11:30 AM on Monday, August 13, 2018 at the Chamber office, 148 E. Ash Street in downtown Mason. While not expected to be required, the prizes may be subject to Federal income tax withholding and those monies may be subtracted from the prize and must be immediately paid to the IRS on behalf of the winner.

No organizations or business entities may purchase or sell tickets, unless in the name of specific individuals. No persons under age 18 may buy a MACC Raffle Ticket, nor may they be a "Ticket Holder of Record". If you transfer ownership of your ticket, you must do so prior to August 1, 2018 and you **MUST** notify the Mason Area Chamber of Commerce before that date. Buyers of tickets must pay for ticket purchases at once, by cash, check, or VISA/MasterCard. Upon issuance of a ticket, all sales are final and non-refundable. Only employees of the MACC are ineligible to buy raffle tickets. Until payment is received, ownership of all tickets will remain with the MACC.
