MACC Golf Classic Benefits “Aggie” Corner Scholarships

What do golfing, supporting the community, and scholarships all have in common? For Mason area businesspeople, it is the 45th annual Mason Area Chamber of Commerce Golf Classic. They will be golfing and raising funds on Thursday, July 26 at Eldorado Golf Course, 3750 Howell Road, west of Mason.

Presented by Oracle Financial Solutions and sponsored by many other Chamber members, this is one of the



largest networking outings in the region. “In 2016, we had a record number of golfers and granted two Mason High School graduates each a scholarship,” says Aaron Fiedler, MACC Golf Committee chair. “Last year, we were again close to being full, with golfers playing on all three 9-hole courses. That makes it the best sponsorship and networking value for businesspeople in our area.”

If you go online at www.masonchamber.org or call the Chamber office at (517) 676-1046 right away, there is still room to play in this year’s 4-person scramble, which features games and prizes for golfers. The cost for individuals registering early were just \$75 per golfer or \$300 per foursome. Closer to the event date, it is \$85 per person or \$340 per foursome. For this fee, golfers play 18 holes with a complimentary golf cart, have lunch-at-the-turn, get a “goodie bag,” beverages, and dinner at the after-golf “Member Mixer.”

The MACC Golf Classic’s continental breakfast and registration both begin at 8:00 a.m. That is followed by a 9:00 a.m. shotgun start. Meals are sponsored by MACC members and beverage tickets are also provided by event sponsors.

Chamber members and their guests who wish to contribute without golfing may call to reserve a spot at the MACC Golf Classic Member Mixer at 3:00 p.m. Admission to the dinner/mixer is \$20 per person. The member mixer and early dinner is an opportunity for non-golfers to network with other community members.

The MACC Agnes “Aggie” Corner Scholarship, funded by this golf outing, is awarded to worthy Mason High School graduating seniors for their community volunteerism. This past year they awarded scholarships to two deserving students. The 2018 scholarship recipients, Will Sheffield and Zachary Troxell, will be recognized at the outing.
